Flooring (non-porous substrate): Fiberglass-Backed Sheet Vinyl, Luxury Vinyl Tile & Modular Carpet Tile Coverage: 220-240 ft²/per gallon (20.4 - 22.2 m²/per 3.78 L)

3. INSTRUCTIONS

Limitations

· For interior installations only

Preparation

Subfloors must be clean, structurally sound and within flat and level tolerance of manufacturer. All substrates must be free of substances that might inhibit the bond of the adhesive or the performance of the flooring or its installation. All substrate cracks, chips, holes, joints or high spots must be adequately repaired. Patching compounds must be suitable for the use application, cement-based and polymer-modified, and applied according to the manufacturer's instructions.

Installation

Maintain a consistent temperature and ambient relative humidity before, during and after installation (between 65-85°F and 30-50% ambient RH). Follow all industry standards and manufacturer's recommendations for floor flatness, acclimation and application of flooring materials. Large temperature or humidity increases or decreases can affect the flooring and performance of the installation. Lift a corner periodically to ensure 100% coverage of adhesive to the flooring backing and the substrate to ensure a void-free bond. Spread adhesive uniformly. Adhesive ridges should be of sufficient height to achieve full coverage of the substrate and the deepest recesses in the back of the flooring material. Place flooring into the adhesive while the adhesive is still fresh. The amount of time in which you have to place the flooring will vary with temperature and humidity.

Clean-up

Fresh adhesive - warm, soapy water on a clean cloth.

 $\it Dried\ adhesive-$ use mineral spirits sparingly with a clean, white cotton cloth. DO NOT POUR DIRECTLY ONTO FLOORING.
