2. TECHNICAL DATA

Product Type:	Advanced Acrylic Latex
Color:	Beige
Odor:	Very mild, non-offensive
Open Time:	Up to 20 minutes
Working Time:	Up to 30 minutes
Curing Time:	8 to 10 hours. Environmental factors and substrate porosity effect cure rate. Restrict foot traffic and moving of heavy objects for 24 hours to allow adhesive to cure properly. Premature traffic can cause installation failure.
Traffic:	Residential: 24 hours Commercial: 24 hours Rolling Loads: N/A
pH:	Must not exceed 9
Shelf Life:	2 years from date of manufacture when stored in the original unopened container in a controlled environment 50°F - 77°F (10°C - 25°C)
Storage:	Protect from freezing
VOC:	< 2 g/L





3. INSTRUCTIONS

Limitations

- For interior installations only
- Not recommended over non-porous materials or painted surfaces
- Concrete and plaster must be properly seasoned and dry prior to installation

Preparation

Surface must be structurally sound, dry, smooth, level and free all substances (oil, wax, grease, paint, oil based sealers, adhesive residue, etc.) that may inhibit the bond of the adhesive or the performance or its installation.

Installation

Maintain the same temperature and humidity during the life of the installation (between 65–95°F).

Stair treads - Apply 1/4" bead in a zig-zag pattern.

 ${f Moldings} - {f Size}$ of the bead and amount of bead rows will depend upon molding size.

Reducer strips – Apply 1/8" bead to substrate and allow up to 15 min. open time and then install strip.

Starter/endrows – Apply 1/4" bead along the entire back of plank. Surface conditions and type of wood product will ultimately determine bead size and coverage.

Clean-up

Fresh adhesive - warm, soapy water

Dried adhesive – mineral spirits sparingly on a clean, cotton cloth. DO NOT POUR DIRECTLY ONTO FLOORING.
